ACTIVITIES DURING THE YEARS 2021-2022:

The Branch had minimum activities during the last year, mainly owing to the pandemic and also due to issues in the licencing and bank accounts. Presently the branch has renewed the licence and has a new Bank Account with the bank of Baroda.

The Chairman had to relocate to Qatar and other members were busy with the remote working patterns during the pandemic.

However, we have revived back the branch with a web meeting held on 21st September 2021, wherein the present committee was nominated.

The branch also participated in support for the "Safety At Sea" conference held by Tristar group during the Dubai Expo at the Indian Pavilion on 08th December 2021.

Another committee meeting was held on 24th March 2022 at Quest Marine office and plans for organising the next AGM event and support sponsorship was discussed.

MEMBERSHIP:

The membership for the branch has not increased much and has been maintained steady at about 25.

SUPPORT SPONSORSHIP:

We are planning to re-initiate a support sponsorship program , inviting companies to become support sponsors so as to have sufficient funds to organise own events and topics of common interest rather than depend on companies to sponsor the entire event and speak on topics of their interest.

FUTURE PLANS, EVENTS & PROPOSALS:

Below listed are some proposals and suggestions, which we would need the full approval, advise and support of the head quarters before even taking the next step ahead. We hope this would be discussed and decided to move ahead with these proposals:

- The AGM and event planned with sponsorship from M/s Advanced Watertek and presentations from Mr Unnikrishnan, Manager ABS on "Hybrid Power Systems in the Offshore Industry". This event was initially planned on 16th June, but now postponed to 28th June 2022.
- 2. The main event ahead is the Biannual seminar which is planned for November 2022. We have planned with support from Abu Dhabi Maritime Training Center at their premises. We still need to finalise the topics/speakers and most importantly have the sponsorship to take us through the event.
- 3. There is an acute need to increase the membership and a more vigorous drive would be initiated to increase membership. However, for this, we would need to provide the added perks in being an IIMS member and this would require us in meeting with port authorities, Insurance authorities, etc, to impress them that they would be safe to follow IIMS membership as a criterion to enforce the requirements for companies to carry out surveys in their premises and/or for their client.

To conclude this report, we look forward to all guidance and support from the head quarters and the previous office bearers/honorary members to take this branch forward in the same proactive path taken so far.
